Working with the Nerang Scout Group, the children will have the opportunity to participate in an overnight camp at Guanaba Scout campsite. The children will participate in a camp run by experienced Scouting Leaders and current Nerang youth members.

The camp is based on Scout's Earth Tribe program which teaches us about the environment and the effects humans are having on it.
